





1/3 of students at host schools participated in afterschool programming








One-third of all students at OUSD host schools participated in afterschool programming

2019-2020 Evaluation Findings How well did we do it?

<u>Safety</u>

92% of school leaders agree: Programs provide **a safe place** for students.



School-Day Alignment

94% of school leaders agree: They are satisfied with the level of **communication** between school leadership and program staff.

92% of school leaders agree: The site coordinator has **regular meetings** with school staff to maximize alignment.

Sense of belonging and mental wellness

94% of school leaders agree: Programs provide **a safe place** for students.

92% of school leaders agree: Programs help students **learn how to get along with others**.

MM Participant Survey – Content

 - Since coming to this program, I feel I have more control over things that happen to me
 - ≻I feel like I belong at this program
- Added question around keeping up with schoolwork

>I feel like I am keeping up with my schoolwork

Participant Survey – Logistics

- We are currently working on getting the surveys translated into Arabic, Chinese (simplified), Spanish, and Vietnamese
- Online links for participant surveys will be sent out in early March with a detailed guide on how to frame and administer the survey to youth, given the context
